




But for a newcomer, one question looms large...

The Classic Experience: Functional, but Familiar.






A dense Windows utility UI, perfect for quick installation.


A portal-style grid that serves as a complete registry.

The **Operational View**. Where you install and manage plugins.

The **Registry View**. The source of truth for plugin metadata.


The **Story View**. A modern marketplace to discover and share what the ecosystem offers.

How a Modern Tool is Built.

On paper, this is a React/Vite/Tailwind static site. In reality, it's a story about a new way to build—letting AI handle the scaffolding while a domain expert focuses on the shape and feel of the experience.

The human expert pokes holes, asks for fixes, and wires it all together until the UI feels right.


